Exhibition Schedule:

Application deadline: December 2, 2011

Jurying of submitted images: December 5-9, 2011

Notification of Acceptance: December 16, 2011

Delivery of Works: In-person delivery: Tuesday, January 3, 2012: 10-5. Shipped works should arrive at the Center by January 3 in sturdy, reusable containers. (Please, no "popcorn" packing materials.)

Opening Reception: Saturday, January 7, 2012- 6-9 pm

Exhibition Closes: Sunday, February 5, 2012

Pick up of unsold works: Monday, February 6, 2012: 10-5.

Entry Fees: [FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE]

Cedarburg Cultural Center and Cedarburg Artists' Guild Members: \$25, Non-Members: \$35
All fees are payable to the Cedarburg Cultural Center.

Awards: **Best of Show: \$300 and a solo exhibit in one of the CCC's galleries.**

Professional Awards: First Place \$200, Second Place \$100

Juror: The Little Show will be juried by a professional Wisconsin artist.

Application Process: Please submit images of the actual work to be exhibited. You may choose to exhibit 4-5 miniatures (see requirements below) OR 1-2 large scale works (see requirements below).

Submit your images on a CD saved as jpegs. One image per title. Image title must contain your last name and number to correspond with the entry form (ie. smith1.jpg, smith2.jpg, smith3.jpg). Image must be in upright viewing manner. Please check to be sure that your images can be opened. (If you need your CD returned, please provide a SASE and adequate return postage for the CD.)

Submission Requirements:

Artists may submit:

A maximum of 5 miniatures-

For 2D works: Image size may not exceed 25 square inches (for example, 5x5" or 3x 8 1/3"). Overall size (size including frame dimensions), must not exceed 64 square inches (for example 8 x 8"). 2D works may be in any media and must be ready for display/installation. No sawtooth hangers, please. Works should be clearly labeled on the backside with your full name, title of the work, medium and price. All work is required to be available for purchase. For 3D works: works must not exceed 8 inches in any dimension, including the base. Sculptural work must stand firmly on its own if not mounted to a base.

OR

A maximum of 2 large-scale works-

For 2D works: Image size must meet a minimum of 1280 square inches. (for example, 32 x 40" or 20 x 64", etc). 2D works may be in any media and must be ready for display/installation, with framed or wrapped/painted edges, and fitted with hanging wire. No sawtooth hangers, please. Works should be clearly labeled on the backside with your full name, title of the work, medium and price. All work is required to be available for purchase. For 3D works: works must meet a minimum of 36 inches in at least one dimension, including the base. Sculptural work must stand firmly on its own if not mounted to a base.

Insurance/ Liability: By submission of any work, the artist agrees to abide by the exhibition rules and waives any and all claims for loss or damage against the Cedarburg Cultural Center or any individuals or entities associated with the exhibit.

Sales/Commission: The Center will retain a standard commission of 35% on all other sales. All work must be priced, available for sale, and must remain until the end of the show. No price or title changes may be made after entry.

The Venue:

The mission of the Cedarburg Cultural Center is to provide a gathering place to celebrate community, arts and local heritage. The Center's galleries are free and open to the public Tuesday through Saturday from 10am - 5pm, and Sunday from 12 - 4pm. The Center is closed to the public on Mondays. The Center's galleries, classrooms and restrooms are fully wheelchair accessible.
