Saturday, August 30 - Sunday, October 12, 2025.

- Artists residing in or maintaining a studio in Ozaukee or Washington counties, who are current members of the Cedarburg Artist’s Guild (CAG), are invited to submit entries for the 2025 Annual Juried Exhibit (AJE) at the Cedarburg Cultural Center (CCC).

October 14	Tuesday	Artists pick up artwork, 10 am - 5 pm

Artwork entries accepted:

- All media is accepted - 2D and 3D, including pottery, fiber arts, glass, woodworking, metal sculpture, leather work, assemblage, and jewelry.
- We encourage 3D artists to apply - awards will be given in the 3D category.
- Artwork must be artist’s own original concept, design, and execution completed within the last 3 years.
- Artwork cannot have previously been exhibited in a CCC or CAG exhibition except for Main Street Gallery.
- Each artwork must be framed properly to hang with wire and ready for display – no notched tooth hangers or wet paint. Unframed canvases must have edges painted.
- Each artist may submit up to three pieces of artwork. The dimensions of the artwork are limited to 3 feet in width and 5 feet in height, except for one (1) piece, which may exceed 3 feet in width but must not exceed 5 feet in width.

High Quality Photos

- Name Image files with exact name, **artist_title of artwork**; for example, **smith_sunshinyday**.
- Image should capture only the artwork (please do not show frame or mat).
- Image should be in a correct upright viewing position, not sideways or upside down.

Entry Fee

- CAG members may enter up to three pieces of artwork for a total entry fee of \$40.

Drop off and pick-up

- **Deliver accepted artwork** to the CCC, Tuesday, August 26, 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- **Pick up artwork** (*if not sold*) on Tuesday, October 14, 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Note: Artists unavailable during the scheduled pick-up time must arrange an alternative. The Cedarburg Cultural Center (CCC) assumes no responsibility for the security or damage of artwork dropped off or picked up outside the designated times. Artwork not collected within two weeks will become the property of the CCC. Additionally, packaging materials cannot be stored on-site.

- Awards in 3 - Dimensional category: **1 blue, 1 red, 2 honorable mentions**

Sales

The Cedarburg Cultural Center will retain a 35% commission on artwork sold during the exhibition for its members, and a 40% commission for non-members.

Liability & Insurance

In the event of an insurance claim, all artwork accepted into the 2025 CAG Annual Juried Exhibit will be insured for the amount indicated as the "price/insurance value" on the CCC insurance form - beginning upon delivery, Tuesday, August 26, 2025, and ending on Tuesday October 14, 2025. While the Cedarburg Cultural Center is insured for loaned property, the coverage provided by the CCC is in excess over any other insurance available on the loaned exhibit items. To protect both the CCC and owners of loaned exhibit items, the CCC reserves the right to request insurance documentation and to limit the value of items accepted.

I agree that all submitted artwork is created by the artist. No works from copyrighted images or photos taken by anyone other than the artist is permitted. Submission of artwork indicates acceptance of all conditions and policies set forth. All accepted and installed artwork must remain in the exhibit until pick up date on Tuesday, October 14, 2025.
