

Where should I paint?? Check back often to see new locations to paint

The following locations are in the 234 square miles that make up Ozaukee County. Sites within **Cedarburg** boundaries qualify for *Fresh From Cedarburg* and are **highlighted** & **underlined**. Locations that open AFTER sunrise and close BEFORE sunset are noted with an *asterisk; however, the artist is responsible for verifying the hours for their chosen locations. Blue Heron Wildlife Sanctuary 4030 Highway O, Saukville. 92-acre wildlife sanctuary dedicated to protecting native wildlife and vegetation on the west bank of the Milwaukee River. Open to the public during daylight hours

Cedarburg Art Museum, W63N67 Washington Avenue, Cedarburg. This is a grand building of red brick and classical architecture. Respite under the huge shade trees in the beer garden and/or dodge the rain under the stage overhang or gazebo. Be sure to look at the current show inside.

Covered Bridge Park, Cedar Creek & Covered Bridge Roads north of Highway 60. It is the sole surviving covered bridge in Wisconsin. There is plenty of parking and public restrooms.

Downtown Cedarburg Historic District Our collectors have a strong history of buying paintings of the iconic scenes in the historic downtown.

Forest Beach Migratory Preserve, 4979 Country Club Road, Belgium. Forests, ravines, wetlands, grasslands, prairies and migratory birds on Lake Michigan.

Harrington Beach State Park, 531 City Highway D, Belgium. One mile of sandy beach on Lake Michigan, wetland pond and limestone quarry. Entrance fee \$.

Jonathon Clark House Museum, 11333 N. Cedarburg Road, Mequon. Artists are invited to capture the beautiful setting of an 1848 stone house and grounds.

***Lion's Den Gorge Nature Preserve**, 511 High Bluff Drive, Grafton. Enjoy ½ mile of 90-100' bluffs with tremendous views of Lake Michigan.

Mequon Nature Preserve, 8200 W. County Line Road, Mequon. Restored natural habitat with trails, wetlands, fields and an observation tower. Pet friendly.

Ozaukee County Historical Society, N57W6406 Center Street, Cedarburg. Cedarburg's former train depot and Cream City brick building.

Pioneer Village, 4880 County Rd I, Saukville. A collection of over 24 restored buildings and structures dating from the 1840s to early 1900's, in a unique rural village setting. Open Saturday & Sundays noon -5 pm, Mon & Tues 8 am -4 pm

Port Washington harbor and historic downtown. A quaint respite with a large, boat-filled harbor & ongoing fishing. Charming downtown businesses and historic churches.

Riveredge Nature Center, 4458 County Highway Y, Saukville. Ten miles of trails through forests, prairies and Milwaukee River frontage. Entrance fee \$.

Sauk Creek Nature Preserve, 3210 County Highway KK, Port Washington. Follow the creek as it flows over limestone bedrock ledges and a small waterfall.

***Virmond Park**, 10606 N. Lake Shore Drive, Mequon. The 63-acre park has breathtaking panoramic views from the bluffs that overlook Lake Michigan.

Wisconsin Museum of Quilts and Fibert Arts, N50W5050 Portland Road, Cedarburg. The Museum is housed in a repurposed 1850's barn.

Nancy Going's (Private residence & Cedarburg Artists Guild member) turn of the century farm with outbuildings, gardens and 2 horses. 6503 Pleasant Valley Road, Town of Cedarburg 53024
